

# Toos Publication History and Background




Mr. Mohsen Bagherzadeh, the founder and director of Toos Publication, had born in Mashad in 1938. After finishing his Diploma, he started his professional work as a Journalist with different local Journals and later with Capital City, Tehran, and Newspapers. The year 1951 was starting point of his cooperation with the bookshops and bookbinding companies, when he began his job as a salesman in

Gutemberg Printing House and Bookshop (one of the most famous and old publications). Attachment to the book, urged Mr. Bagherzadeh to choose this profession as his permanent task; so, the next year, he became sales manager of Gutemberg. Meanwhile, he established Toos Publication in 1959 and besides, he continued his activities as a journalist. The first book printed by Toos, was Khorassan's Contemporary Poetry and after that, more three appeared in Bazar and this moment was point of departure for Mr. Bagherzadeh to move to a big City like Tehran. In Capital City, he preferred to work with a Cultural Society like Foundation for Culture of Iran as well. The outcome of this attempt was precious experiences of

knowledge, intellectual principles and practical methods of Book Processing, being accessed from scholars and the Masters of wisdom. Anyhow, engagement in such activities did not disturb his duties to progresses Toos Publishing House. In 1971, the first Toos Bookshop was established and started to work opposite to Tehran University, which is active till this day. Onto year 1977 most of the Toos books being published, were Social and Political and in few cases, Literary works; Since 1978, other subjects, mostly Pre-Islamic Mythology, History and Culture and Classical Persian Literature also included and have been always favorite references to Iranologists and Scholars. Toos has succeeded to publish more than 600 titles during last 43 years, among which some books have been chosen as the book of year and best sellers in International Book Fair of Tehran.

**The**Managing Directors of **Toos** Publishing House has been one of the first founders (as investor and the member of Executive Committee) of Textbooks joint-stock company; **The Encyclopedia for Children and Young People** organization; **Peka** (The Shared Corporation for Book Expansion and Distribution) and at the same time, a partner of Board of Directors of **The Encyclopedia**.

As it is claimed, most of the time he has overturned and altered the history, especially Iranian History, to the extent that even his country fellow-man and companion, Plutarch, has writen a book called *Malice of Herodutos*, to disclose his forge of the documents.



Among the Middle Persian [Pahlavi] texts, Ardavirafnameh probably is the most popularized and fascinating one which usually being compared with Dante's Divine Comedy. The text explains the release of Ardaviraf, Sacred Viraf, to other world and his vision of Paradise and Hell. In fact, by this symbolic journey, man will be aware of the termination of his deed in present life. This text has been translated to Modern Persian and other languages several times; some manuscripts of Ardavirafnameh including pictures have been remained since old times. Two Revised Version of these manuscripts are published respectively in 1872 and 1902. The second extinct one will be published for the first time in Iran. It can be also used as a textbook for instruction of language in general and Pahlavi language in particular, due to its fluent prose and attractive content.
